### What is Crisis Counseling?

The Texas Crisis Counseling Assistance and Training Program provides short-term support to neighboring counties impacted by severe storms and natural disasters.

Our Crisis Counseling Assistance teams are stationed in Hardin, Jasper, and San Jacinto counties (specific location addresses on the right) and are ready to assist individuals during these challenging times.

Operating Monday through Friday from 8 AM to 5 PM, our teams offer stress management education, financial assistance, food and clothing resources, and referrals to local organizations to help individuals with their specific needs.

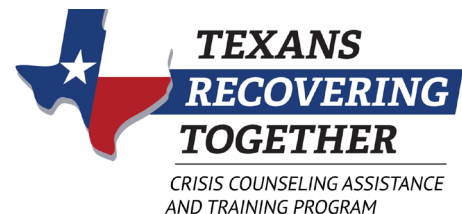
